BYLAWS

ARTICLE I. NAME: The name of this club shall be

YAVAPAI AMATEUR RADIO CLUB

ARTICLE II. OBJECT: The objectives of this club shall be to promote amateur radio by:

- (1) Increasing knowledge.
- (2) improving individual operating proficiency,
- (3) Facilitating the exchange of information,
- (4) Increasing general cooperation between members, and
- (5) Strengthening the well being of amateur radio in the general community.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERS:

Section 1. The members of this club shall be all persons interested in amateur radio who apply for membership and submit their dues.

Section 2. The annual dues shall be as set by the board.

Section 3. Members over three months in arrears in the payment of dues shall be considered inactive, thereby relinquishing all privileges in the club.

ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS:

Section 1. The officers of this club shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer.

Section 2. The officers shall perform the duties prescribed by these bylaws and the parliamentary authority adopted by the club.

Section 3. The officers shall be elected by ballot at the November meeting, their term of office shall begin on One January, and they shall serve for one year.

Section 4. No member shall hold more than one office at a time, and no member shall be eligible to serve more than two consecutive terms in the same office.

Section 5. Vacancies occurring between elections shall be filled by appointment by the Board.

ARTICLE V. THE BOARD:

Section 1. The Board shall consist of seven members: the four officers, two members of the club to be elected from the membership at large and the immediate Past-President of the club.

Section 2. The members of the Board shall be elected by ballot at the November meeting, their term of office shall begin on One January, and they shall serve for one year. There shall be no restrictions on consecutive terms.
